ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES

Early Entry – Online	August 16, 2010	\$20 per head
Early Entry – By Mail	August 17, 2010	\$20 per head
Late Entry	September 1, 2010	\$40 per head
Late Late Entry	After September 1, 2010	\$75 per head

Online entries will not be available after August 16, 2010.

The entry fee for any animal purchased at a World Beef Expo sale is \$20 per head. Entries must be received by 7:00 p.m. Saturday, September 25th. A receipt of sale and the original registration paper will authenticate the breed and ownership of World Beef Expo sale animals. Entry forms will be available at the sale and in the entry office.

A bedding fee will be charged for all cattle that are entered **only in Junior Show**. See the entry form for details.

All exhibitors are expected to familiarize themselves with the General Rules & Regulations.

Rules Specific to the Junior Heifer Show

1. **Age of Exhibitors.** Exhibitors must be between the ages of 8 and 21 as of January 1, 2010 to participate in the Junior Heifer Show.
2. **Ownership.** All heifers entered in the Junior Heifer Show must be owned by the participating junior exhibitor on or before check-in time of the Junior Show, with the exception of any animal purchased at a World Beef Expo sale. Junior exhibitors must be present to show their animal(s).
3. **Breed Divisions.**
 - a. **Purebreds.** A purebred breed division must have ten (10) or more heifers entered to earn its own show. Breeds with fewer than ten head entered will show in the Any Other Breed division (Division 329).
 - b. **Percentages.** A low percentage division must have ten (10) or more heifers entered to earn its own show. Low percentage breed divisions with fewer than ten head entered will show in the Low Percentage Any Other Breed division (Division 330).
4. **Classes.** Breed heifers (purebred and low percentage) will be shown youngest to oldest. Commercial heifers will be shown by weight, lightest to heaviest. Show management reserves the right to break and combine classes as needed.

- 27 Cow/Calf Pair – Four (4) years of age and older. Cow calved December 31, 2006 and earlier. Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and may not exceed 280 days of age on day of show.
