**ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES**

Early Entry – Online	August 16, 2010	\$20 per head
Early Entry – By Mail	August 17, 2010	\$20 per head
Late Entry	September 1, 2010	\$40 per head
Late Late Entry	After September 1, 2010	\$75 per head

*Online entries will not be available after August 16, 2010.*

A bedding fee will be charged for all cattle that are entered **only in Junior Show**.

*All exhibitors are expected to familiarize themselves with the General Rules & Regulations.*

**Rules Specific to the Junior Market Steer Show**

1. **Age of Exhibitors.** Exhibitors must be between the ages of 8 and 21 as of January 1, 2010 to participate in the Junior Market Steer Show.
2. **Ownership.** All steers entered in the Junior Market Steer Show must be owned by the participating junior exhibitor on or before check-in time of the Junior Show. Junior exhibitors must be present to show their animal(s).
3. **Breed Divisions.** All divisions – including purebred, percentage, and appendix – must have five (5) or more steers entered to show in their own division class(es). Any divisions with fewer than five entries will show as Any Other Breed (Division 227) or Low Percentage Any Other Breed (Division 228).
4. **Breed Qualifications.** Registrations from respective breed associations are required.
  - **Gelbvieh** (Division 208): PB75 or BA75 or greater
  - **Balancer** (Division 209): BA75 or less
  
  - **Limousin** (Division 212): 75% Limousin or greater
  - **Lim-Flex** (Division 213): 74% Limousin or less
  
  - **Maine-Anjou** (Division 214): 75% Maine-Anjou or greater
  - **Mainetainer** (Division 215): 25-74% Maine-Anjou
  
  - **Shorthorn** (Division 222): 15/16 Shorthorn or greater. Possessing a Red Certificate.
  - **ShorthornPlus** (Division 223): 7/8 Shorthorn or less. Possessing a Green Certificate.
  
  - **Simmental** (Division 224): 7/8 Simmental or greater
  - **Percentage Simmental** (Division 225): Less than 7/8 Simmental
  
  - **Dairy and Dairy/Beef Steers:** Purebred or grade dairy steers and dairy/beef cross steers not registered by a beef association will show in the crossbred steer division.
5. **Classes.** Steers will be shown by weight, lightest to heaviest. Steers must weigh at least 900 lbs. at weigh-in. Show management reserves the right to break classes with 12 or more entries.
