Online entries will not be available after August 16, 2010.

Entry fees include bedding and tie-out space. Bedding will be available upon arrival at World Beef Expo. Exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding for tie-outs.

All exhibitors are expected to familiarize themselves with the General Rules & Regulations. Rules have been revised for the 2010 World Beef Expo.

Rules Specific to the Braunvieh Show

1. Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of the Braunvieh Association of America (BAA) Herdbook. When entry is made, exhibitors agree to abide by the rules and regulations established by the BAA, as well as the rules of show management. Entries found to be misrepresented and/or persons not abiding by the show rules may be disqualified from showing.
2. All animals must be registered in the BAA, and each original certificate must be available for inspection.
3. Animals must fullblood or purebred (7/8 Braunvieh for females, 15/16 Braunvieh for males) to qualify for the Purebred/Fullblood Braunvieh show. Animals with less than purebred Braunvieh blood and at least 1/4 Braunvieh blood will be shown in a separate Beefbuilder percentage show.
4. The BAA reserves the right to provide the judge and audience with the Expected Progeny Difference (EPD) values, ultrasound data collected by a certified technician, scrotal circumference for bulls, and/or weights and rations for performance and weights with weight-per-day-of-age. Performance figures can be presented in their entirety or in any combination deemed necessary by the BAA.
5. Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older (excluding females in the cow/calf classes) must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy from a licensed veterinarian. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection. Females 28 months of age or older must be shown with their most recent natural calf at side.
6. Females born prior to September 1, 2008 must show in the cow/calf division with a calf at side. The pair will not be eligible for champion heifer. Calves exhibited in the cow/calf classes may not exceed 230 days of age. Calves from the cow/calf classes may be entered and shown as individuals.
7. Bulls exhibited at 14 months of age or older must have a positive semen test and a certificate to that effect. This certificate must be available for inspection. Bulls 12 months of age and older must have a nose lead to be shown.
8. Altering the natural color of an animal is not allowed.
9. No cosmetic surgeries other than surgical dehorning are allowed.
10. Only general accepted fitting practices are permitted.

No premiums will be offered for this show.

GROUP CLASSES

Breeder's Herd: Three head, both sexes represented. All individual cattle shown within a group must have the same herd prefix but can be individually owned by immediate family members.
Produce of Dam: Two animals from the same dam. Dam information must be supplied before entering ring.
Get-of-Sire: Three head of any age, both sexes represented, by the same sire.
Best Four Head: Four head of any age, owned or co-owned by one exhibitor.
