### ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES

Early Entry – Online	August 16, 2010	\$60 per head
Early Entry – By Mail	August 17, 2010	\$60 per head
Late Entry	September 1, 2010	\$80 per head
Late Late Entry	After September 1, 2010	\$100 per head

*Online entries will not be available after August 16, 2010.*

Entry fees include bedding and tie-out space. Bedding will be available upon arrival at World Beef Expo. Exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding for tie-outs.

*All exhibitors are expected to familiarize themselves with the General Rules & Regulations. Rules have been revised for the 2010 World Beef Expo.*

### Rules Specific to the Gelbvieh Show

- Eligibility requirements are as follows:
  - Females:** High Percentage Gelbvieh (PB75, greater than BA75) will show together in the Gelbvieh show. 75% Balancers (BA75) may elect to show in either the Gelbvieh Show or the Balancer Show, but not both (see Rule 3).  
Balancers of less than BA75 may only show in the Balancer Show.
  - Bulls:** Registered Gelbvieh bulls – high percentage, purebred, and fullblood (87% - 100%) are eligible to show in the Gelbvieh Show.  
Registered Balancer bulls may only show in the Balancer Show.
- All animals must have original registration papers available on site during the entire show. Each animal must have a legible tattoo that corresponds with the registration papers. World Beef Expo reserves the right to mouth one or all animals. Tattoos and registration papers will be inspected at check-in.
- A 75% female that qualifies to show as a Gelbvieh or Balancer may only be entered and exhibited in one division at a show. Exhibitors must designate Gelbvieh or Balancer as the intended breed division at the time of entry. **No changes will be allowed after entries are received.**
- Cow/Calf Class: All cows shown with a calf over 150 days of age must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exceptions to this rule will be made for donor females that have produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months, as verified by a written statement from a licensed veterinarian. Calves in the cow/calf class may not exceed 240 days of age on the day of show.
- In order to qualify as a Gelbvieh Ring of Gold point show, a minimum of 20 head must be exhibited in the Gelbvieh Show. In order to qualify as a Balancer Ring of Gold point show, a minimum of 20 head must be exhibited in the Balancer Show.

**No premiums will be offered for this show.**
