Online entries will not be available after August 15, 2011.

Entry fees include bedding and tie-out space. Bedding will be available upon arrival at World Beef Expo. Exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding for tie-outs.

All exhibitors are expected to familiarize themselves with the General Rules & Regulations. Rules have been revised for the 2011 World Beef Expo.

Rules Specific to the National Murray Grey Show

In an effort to ensure the greatest ease of admission to the show ring for the greatest number of Murray Grey cattle, and to ensure that all Murray Grey cattle in the United States are shown under the exact same show standards, the American Murray Grey Association sets for the following show standards:

1. All exhibitors must be current members of the American Murray Grey Association (AMGA) or the Canadian Murray Grey Association (CMGA).
2. Animals must be registered with the AMGA or CMGA.
3. Only purebred, registered Murray Greys with a legible tattoo are eligible to show.
4. All cattle must conform to the breed characteristics published by the AMGA.
5. Registered Murray Greys must conform to state health regulations and health requirements of the specific show in which they are entered.
6. Percentage Murray Greys may be shown in "other breed" classes or in classes designated as "Murray Grey Percentage". Percentage females and steers shall be exempt from color and horn standards.
7. All rules of the American Murray Grey Association, Louisville, Kentucky apply.
8. All exhibitors of Murray Grey cattle shall sign and adhere to the Code of Show Ring Ethics adopted by the AMGA Board of Directors.
9. There are to be no changes or additional restrictions placed upon show eligibility by show committees, show chairs or regional associations without prior approval of the AMGA Board of Directors.
