GROUP CLASSES

All group class animals must be exhibited in an individual class.

Group classes will be entered at the show.

All animals in a single group class entry must be owned and exhibited by the same farm or individual and/or by a member of his/her immediate family.

Pair of Heifers: Two heifers, owned by one exhibitor

Pair of Bulls: Two bulls, owned by one exhibitor

Best Three Head: Three head, one or both sexes represented

Best Five Head: Five head, one or both sexes represented

Get-of-Sire: Three animals by the same sire, one or both sexes represented

Produce of Dam: Two animals by the same dam, one or both sexes represented
