Online entries will not be available after August 15, 2011.

Entry fees include bedding and tie-out space. Bedding will be available upon arrival at World Beef Expo. Exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding for tie-outs.

All exhibitors are expected to familiarize themselves with the General Rules & Regulations. Rules have been revised for the 2011 World Beef Expo.

Rules Specific to the Simmental Show

1. All animals must have original registration papers available on site during the entire show. Each animal must have a legible tattoo that corresponds with its registration paper. Tattoos and registration papers will be inspected at check-in. World Beef Expo reserves the right to mouth one or all animals.
2. Eligibility requirements are as follows:
 - Females: Purebred – 7/8 Simmental or greater
Percentage – 1/2 to 3/4 Simmental
 - Bulls: Purebred – 7/8 Simmental or greater
Percentage – 1/2 to 3/4 Simmental
3. All bulls one year of age or older must be shown with a nose lead and/or nose ring.
4. Only one showperson per animal will be allowed inside the show ring.
5. Show order will follow what is printed in the entry guide. Classes will be judged youngest to oldest, with the youngest animals entering the ring first. Any animal that is not at ringside when its class enters the ring will be scratched from that class.
6. World Beef Expo reserves the right to bar any animal from showing that does not meet the requirements of the show, as well as to bar from future shows any exhibitor who does not comply with the show rules.
7. The purebred Simmental show is a Progress Through Performance (PTP) show.
 - a. The show will be conducted according to the American Simmental Association's PTP guidelines.
 - b. Bulls' scrotal circumferences may be measured and/or ultrasounded.
 - c. The judge will be provided with current EPD information.
 - d. All animals must be registered with the American Simmental Association.
8. The percentage Simmental show will not follow PTP rules. All percentage Simmentals must be registered with the American Simmental Association and have original registration papers at the time of check-in.
9. Breeds with separate low-percentage divisions are considered to have two separate shows. Refer to Rule 12 of the General Rules & Regulations for details.

No premiums will be offered for this show.

GROUP CLASSES

Get of Sire: Three animals of any age sired by one bull, both sexes represented. Animals may be owned by multiple exhibitors.

Produce of Dam: Two animals by one dam, either sex. Animals may be owned by multiple exhibitors.

Breeder's Group: Four animals, both sexes represented. Animals must be bred and owned by exhibitor.
