

YOUTH SWEEPSTAKES

PHOTO JOURNALISM

This division allows the contestant to select photographs and write a story describing them. The story can be written to describe any aspect of the photos. Exhibitors are invited to be as creative as they desire.

This is not a research paper.

Entries will be accepted from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday, September 23rd.

All entries must be received by 9 a.m. on Saturday, September 24th.

There will be a \$10 entry fee for those who participate in one or more of the following Sweepstakes contests:

Livestock Judging
Photo Journalism
Practical Herdsmanship
Public Speaking
Sales Talk

The \$10 entry fee must be paid, in U.S. currency, at the time of Youth Sweepstakes registration.

Entries must be paid in cash or by check (payable to World Beef Expo).

Photo Journalism Contest Guidelines

1. The story and photo board may be turned in during Youth Sweepstakes office hours on Friday, September 23rd. All entries must be received by 9 a.m. on Saturday, September 24th. The Youth Sweepstakes entry office is located in the upper level of the double deck barn.
All Photo Journalism entries will be judged at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday.
2. Requirements: Five (5) photographs (each 4" x 6" in size) mounted on a black 16" x 20" poster board. The exhibitor's name and age – as of January 1st – must be on the back of the poster board.
3. No professional photography is allowed, and photos may not be digitally enhanced – with the exception of brightness and contrast adjustments. **ALL PHOTOS MUST BE TAKEN BY THE CONTESTANT WITHIN THE CURRENT YEAR.**
4. The photos must be related to the agriculture industry (i.e. livestock, farm landscapes, people around livestock and/or a farm, etc.). In your own words, write a story that the photos illustrate.
5. Story length guidelines: Junior Division – 100 to 150 words
Intermediate Division – 150 to 200 words
Senior Division – 200 to 250 words
6. Typed stories are preferred, but legible handwritten stories will also be accepted. Typed stories should be in 12-point font and double-spaced. Handwritten stories should be written on one side of the paper.
7. Scoring will be based on photograph quality, photo story and overall presentation.
8. After they are judged, the photo exhibits will be on display in the lower level of the double deck barn.
9. All entries will be available for pick-up after the conclusion of Junior Show on Sunday.
